



A Summer Fallow Field gone

In these two fields soil moisture tests were made at the time of planting, in mid-season, and again at about the time that the corn was mature. Soil moisture tests will be made again in these fields next Spring at the time of seeding. The important comparison, however, will be in the observation of the effect the different crops and soil treatment will have on the succeeding crop.

Three four-page illustrated circular letters on summer tillage covering the place of summer tillage in the dry-land farming system, methods of tillage, implements used, etc., were mailed to all farmers in the county.

(D). Livestock Production

Better Sires

A movement has been started for the formation of a co-operative bull association in one community. No definite action has been taken as yet but we have every reason to expect that the Association will Materialize. A Shorthorn sire of very high quality has been located for the Association. If this project does carry thru it will be an important achievement. We hope then to be able to get one or two other communities to take similar action so that a "Bull-Ring" Association may be formed.

Swine

One of the leading club projects being adopted for 1922 is the Corn and Pig Club. We expect to secure some good registered bred gilts for a few of the club members and then use the small pigs to supply other club members.
