Summary of Activities and Accomplishments

In order that the County Agent may be of maximum service to the county it is necessary that he be relieved of the details involved in carrying on the program of work. This can only be done by having efficient help in the Extension office to take care of the details of administration and records and by having project leaders in the communities who will take care of the details in connection with the various projects in the field.

A good program of work was adopted for the year of 1923. Not all of the projects adopted were completed as well as they might have been but on the whole, all inferring factors considered, the year 1923 has been a successful year. Much remains to be done along the same lines as those outlined by the 1923 program of work. The 1924 program will no doubt be very largely a continuation of the projects now under way.

From the Agent's point of view the greatest task for the next year is the improvement of the community organizations, the development of wider contacts in the county, the shifting of greater responsibilities to the local leaders and improvement in office administration to the end that the Agent may be relieved of multifarious details which interfere with effective work.
